HIGH SCHOOL ORATORICAL PROGRAM

The American Legion High School Oratorical Scholarship Program aims to enhance high school students' understanding and appreciation of the U.S. Constitution, fostering leadership, clear communication, and readiness for the responsibilities of American citizenship. Eligible participants must be U.S. citizens, under 20 years old on the national contest date, enrolled in high school or junior high school (grades 9-12) with no concurrent college enrollment, and must compete in the department (state) where they reside or attend school.

Deadline: Local Contests, December 7, 2026

JUNIOR SHOOTING SPORTS

Each year, The American Legion of Iowa hosts a Department (State) Match, an open competition for affiliated shooting clubs in Iowa promoting marksmanship and gun safety education for youth. Scholarships and trophies are awarded to top shooters and teams. Clubs must file affiliation forms by December 15 to participate.
